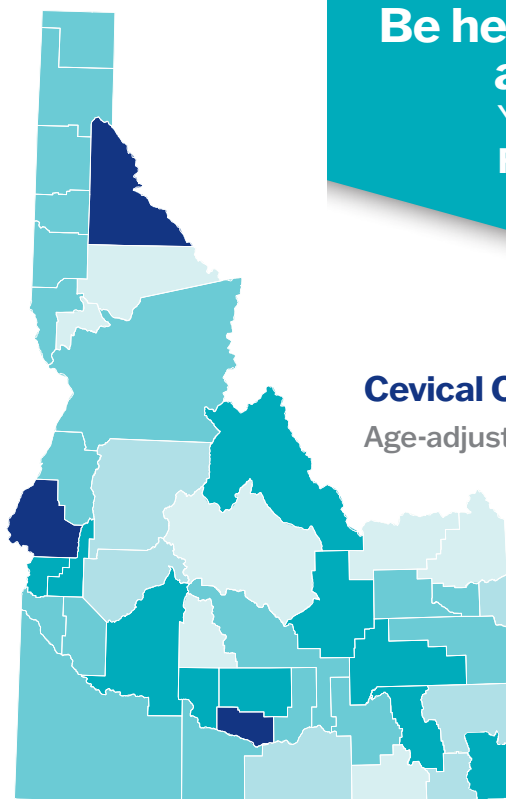
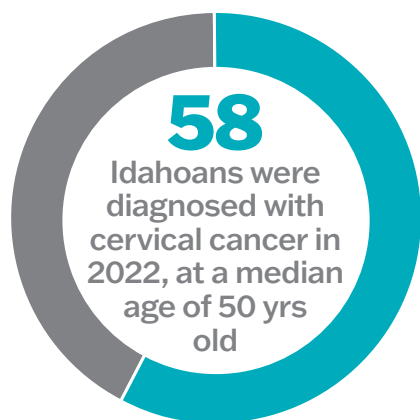
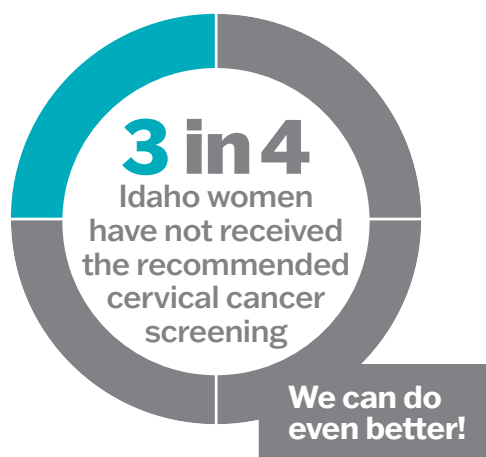


# Cervical Cancer in Idaho

Compared to other cancers in Idaho, cervical cancer affects women at a younger age. It's important to get regular cervical cancer screenings. Screening may include a Pap test, a human papillomavirus (HPV) test, or both.

## RECOMMEND GUIDELINES:

- **Women 21 to 29 years**  
Pap test every three years.
- **Women 30 to 65 years**  
Pap test and a HPV test (co-testing) every five years.
- **HPV vaccinations**  
Protect individuals from six different cancers including cervical cancer.

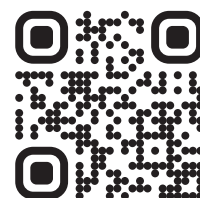
